Masters Programme in Environmental Management and Policy (EMP)

It is no longer possible to be admitted to the below programme outline with the two different entry tracks for the basic block of courses.

Students admitted to the programme in 2017 will follow this old outline, but all new students admitted in 2018 and onwards, or coming back from study leave after September 2018 and onwards, will follow the new outline as described on the IIIEE website and via www.universityadmissions.se .

- **Basic Block**, 30 credits. There are two different entry tracks to the programme.
  - Web based, part time, October June: This track is conducted online at half speed, which makes it possible to combine studies with other activities such as internships or work.
  - Campus based, full time, January May: For students who are required to study full time on campus due to scholarship or student loan requirements, an on-site coordinated track is available.
- **Advanced Block**, 30 credits, August December. Full-time, campus based. From this semester, there is a departure from the traditional division of courses by subject and the courses instead **focus on problem areas**.
- **Applied Block**, 30 credits, January May. Full time, campus based. The second half of the programme focuses on **application of knowledge**, involving projects with external organisations and individual research.
- **Master Thesis Block**, 30 credits, June October. Full time, campus based. Graduation week with theses defenses takes place on campus in late September.
